## **POLICY STATEMENT:**

NNPCN (N/PS) has produced, and will continue to produce, written information in pamphlets (Forms 038 & 039) advertising the services provided in the community. A Committee of the Board addresses community awareness issues.

## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. The information includes:
  - History of NNPCN
  - Mission Statement
  - Referral Process
  - Types of supports provided
  - Who provides the service
  - Target Population
  - Availability of the service
  - Catchment area
  - Any specialty services
  - Recruitment
- 2. The individual rights of persons receiving community services are fully respected.
- 3. Information pamphlets, in French and English, are available to the public through doctors' offices, hospitals, long-term care facilities and other community agencies.
- 4. NNPCN (N/PS) actively pursues opportunities to develop partnerships, consultations and programs with providers of palliative care and bereavement support.

5. NNPCN (N/PS) provides education and awareness training to clients, families and a wide range of community caregivers. The material and programs are sensitive to the needs of various ethno-cultural and special needs groups in the community.

The target groups include:

- Individual, and their family/caregivers, clients requesting palliative care and bereavement services
- Caregivers requesting respite support
- Community agencies, hospitals and long term care facilities referring clients/families for palliative care/support and/or requesting training
- Community agencies requesting information seminars/workshops
- 6. While English is the operating language of this agency, French-speaking clients will be accommodated wherever possible in their first language. To this end, NNPCN (N/PS) will attempt to recruit French-speaking volunteers for every Volunteer Training Program. Every effort will be made to provide volunteer support in the first language of the client and family.
