They have been providing these services and support to the District of the East Parry Sound for more than thirty-six years, their region extending from Callander to Emsdale and all the way over to the Magnetawan area.

Their Mission: The Almaguin Highlands Community Living mission is to provide a wide range of support and services that can vary to individuals with developmental disabilities on a day-to-day basis, depending on the individuals needs. They also educate, not just to the full community, but to the families, the individuals supported, and to our staff, to apply the individuals with developmental disabilities with inclusion, aspiration, rights and contribution to our community.

Their Vision:

- They would like to be known as the transparent organization with staff that are highly motivated that feel valued.
- The acceptance and activities of Almaguin Highlands Community Living will be well acknowledged and appreciated in the community.
- To provide a full inclusive community and related opportunities to each individual that is supported by the association, within their own community.

Services Offered

- Community Participation Support
 - The community participation support provides services that are social, recreational and vocational.

- Residential and Supported Independent Living
 - The residential service provides individuals with disabilities the ability and independence to live independently in an apartment or a house, or in a group living setting.

 - The Support Independent Living programs supports the individuals with disabilities living in their own home or their own apartment.

- Respite Services
 - Provides short-term assistance to the main caregiver of the individual who has a developmental disability, and provides accommodations such as, activities of daily living, personal care, and recreations and leisures.

- Transitions
 - The Transitions Program provides individuals with skills while attending high school.

- Family Support Programs
 - Provides services such as the Transitional Aged Youth, the in/out of home respite programs, family home program, and passport funding support.

- Family Home
 - The family home program provides support and services for children with developmental disabilities who are in long term care, when the family of the individual cannot support the individual needs, and the family home program can meet those needs.

- Person Centered Planning
 - Person Centered Planning helps the individual with the disability reach their goal and that all are achieved.
